



FILMING, PHOTOGRAPHY AND MEDIA ACCESS AGREEMENT

Terms and conditions for media, film crews and photographers

visiting Dreamworld and WhiteWater World

Thank you for joining us at Dreamworld and WhiteWater World. To ensure you get the most out of your visit, please read and sign off on the following terms and conditions for media and film crews in-park.

- All media and filming requests must be approved by Dreamworld prior to arrival.
- All crews must undergo a safety induction online and provide necessary documents preferably one week before entering the park.
- Safety requirements and in-park processes must be adhered to at all times. If breached, filming / photography may be stopped and the crew asked to leave the park.
- Any equipment including Go Pros and other cameras on rides and slides must be approved prior to arrival. Dreamworld does not accept any risk of damage to equipment at any time.
- On-site filming with drones is generally not permitted unless it is commissioned directly by Dreamworld management and is approved under CASA and Dreamworld's operational and safety procedures.
- Filming and photography in DreamWorks Experience and ABC KIDS WORLD and of the relevant characters must be approved prior to filming. This process can require up to two weeks to seek necessary approvals.
- Character and mascot suits not owned/ operated by Dreamworld are not permitted in-park.
- Use of DreamWorks, ABC KIDS or Wiggles Intellectual Property may require approval prior to use. Allow at least 10 days for this approval process. These approvals are subject to change or withdrawal at the discretion of the Intellectual Property owner.
- All Dreamworld guests, staff, characters and wildlife must be presented in a respectful manner in all filming and photos.
- Filming of park guests is not permitted without written consent.
- Dreamworld does not permit filming in back-of-house areas without specific permission prior to approval.
- Filming is subject to weather conditions. Some rides and attractions may not be operable in wet or undesirable weather.
- Film crews may be charged for any damage to Dreamworld equipment and infrastructure caused during filming.
- All filming must only be used for the agreed purpose and cannot be on-sold or used for other purposes without direct permission from Dreamworld.
- The Dreamworld logo and Dreamworld Intellectual Property is to be clearly represented and may not be altered in any way.
- All filming and photography on Dreamworld property (including WhiteWater World) is at the discretion of Dreamworld management and if required Dreamworld reserves the right to cease filming / photography at any time.
